Through the “Think, Talk, Create” framework, they ask grandparents about their thoughts and provide a short description of no more than 200 words in the space below and create either a hand-drawing (for Primary School) or an AI-generated piece (for Secondary School) for the competition. To enhance communication and mutual understanding between grandparents and grandchildren through collaboration, the description may be written by the grandparents themselves or by the grandchildren on their behalf.**

Terms and conditions

1. Each participant may submit only one entry and **must** complete the questionnaire.
2. All entries must be submitted and received by the organiser on or before the specified deadline (based on receipt, not postmark). Late submissions will not be accepted.
3. Participants may collect their entries and certificates according to arrangements announced in September 2026. Unclaimed entries and certificates will be disposed of thereafter.
4. Entries must be original, unpublished artworks that do not infringe copyright. Works previously submitted to other competitions will not be accepted.
5. By submitting their entries, participants grant the organiser the right to edit, reproduce, archive, publish, promote, exhibit, and print the entries without prior approval or compensation. The organiser retains full and final rights of use.
6. All entries will be reviewed and must not contain elements of pornography, violence, inappropriate content, or commercial promotion.
7. Personal information collected will be used for communication and administrative purposes related to the event only.
8. Copyright of all submitted entries shall belong to the organiser.
9. Participants must ensure that all personal information provided is accurate. The organiser shall not be responsible for any loss arising from incorrect or incomplete contact details, including the inability to notify winners or deliver prizes.
10. Winners may be required to attend the award presentation ceremony and participate in event-related photography or publicity. No objections will be accepted.
11. Participants must comply with all rules and regulations of the competition.
12. Decisions made by the judging panel are final and binding. No objections will be accepted.
13. The organiser reserves the right to amend these rules, reject entries, or disqualify any participants without prior notice. In the event of any dispute, the organiser's decision shall be final.
